Description of the exercise	In advance, print and cut the proverbs so that each proverb appears on a separate card. Count the number of participants in the group and select enough cards to equal the number of participants. If there is an uneven number of participants, the leader must participate in this activity. Mix up the cards and pass out one card to each participant. When all cards have been distributed, ask participants to think of a proverb with a similar meaning from their own culture. Discussion: This activity shows that although we have many differences when we compare ourselves to other kinds of people, we also have many similarities. We may have different ways of talking and different behavior patterns, but many of our most basic needs and interests are similar.
